From the Palace of Versailles to the Canal du Midi, the Bay of Mont Saint Michel, the Loire Valley or the jurisdiction of Saint Emilion, France is considered the most romantic country in the world. Large West region of France will surprise you with the beauty of its castles such as the Rocher Portail, Fougères Castle, or the Castles of the Dukes of Brittany, Castles of Chambord and Castles of Chenonceau.

France will also charm you with its 216 "Small City of Character" ("Petite Cité de Caractère®" in French) throughout Brittany and France. In the heart of Brittany, nourished by the legend of King Arthur, the Forest of Broceliande is the largest forest of the region.

Among the French national parks, Kaleid'Ouest suggests the Camargue to contemplate the beau-ty and grace of pink flamingos and horses.


The Chausey archipelago, the largest archipelago in Europe, will surprise you with its tides and its exceptional diversity of fauna and flora! The archipelago of the 7 islands is a unique place in France because it shelters the most important ornithological reserve.

By foot or by panoramic train to the top of the Puy du Dôme (1465 meters), the grandeur of the Auvergne volcanoes will offer you a 360° view on the most beautiful volcanic chain in Europe.

Go down into one of the unique underground caves in France: the "Gouffre de Padirac" in Dordogne!

A surprising world. The site of the Gorges du Verdon is unique, visitors come from all over the world. Its dimensions make it famous as the largest canyon in Europe!

There are many French natural sites, we will be very pleased to help you discover them: The bay of Mont Saint-Michel, The Calanques of Cassis, The Dune of Pilat, The Poitevin marsh or the cliffs of Etretat. Let's not forget Corsica, a paradisiacal Mediterranean island!



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
